

Timken Scholarship for needy through Vidyasaarathi (NSDL) and TISS (Tata Institute of Social Sciences)

Vidyasaarathi is a technology-enabled initiative by NSDL e-Governance Infrastructure Limited (NSDL e-Gov) along with Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) to bridge the gap in education finance in the country through an online platform. Students can search and apply for various education finance schemes they're qualified for. Fund providers, industries, and corporates can promote skill development by designing education finance schemes in Vidyasaarathi and manage the same. The solution would help them manage the entire online education finance application lifecycle i.e. submission and review of application, award of scholarship, disbursement of funds, and renewal of education finance.

Proposal

To support student pursuing B.E, B Tech., ITI, Nursing and Diploma courses, from financially weak background with their fee. Eligibility criteria is set as minimum with score requirement as 50% and family income below 8 lacs. The process goes as follows:

- Scheme Designing & Publishing on VS Platform
- Grant Disbursal to Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS)
- Registration of Students on the Vidyasaarathi Platform
- Receiving Applications and Screening
- Shortlisting and Approval of the Student
- Amount disbursal

Human Healing Foundation

Human Healing Foundation (HHF) is a charitable organization with its mission of healing the non-healing wounds, resolving the unresolved and preventing the preventable ailments. HHF is pursuing to reduce the gap in the quality of infrastructure and the care needed for Burns services offered especially to the poor and underprivileged in Bangalore as a model for the rest of the country as the bigger picture. One of the HHF focus is public awareness about burns, its causes and consequences especially amongst the urban poor where the instances are more, followed by places where the occupational hazards are high.

Project Description

This project aimed at setting-up a 4-bed burns ICU hospital in Bangalore for underprivileged patients. Most of these patients fall under 'Below poverty line' and can't afford to avail expensive treatments in private hospitals and also don't always get optimum care in the Government aided institutions which typically have very low survival rates for burns more than 30% TBSA (total body surface area). This '4 bed burns ICU' initiative focuses on optimal care for improved survival rates for the burn victims. This 'Burns ICU' is set up in the premises of GVG Invivo Hospital located at JP Nagar, Bangalore. The hospital management agreed to provide the space and much-needed manpower which is key to support a project of this type and magnitude as it demands highly skilled and dedicated team.

Fund

Funded amount from Timken India Limited is Rs. 85,00,000 towards setting-up the 'Burn ICU' with equipment like, ICU Beds with cubicles, Monitors, Ventilators, Motorized air mattresses, Syringe pumps, infusion pumps, Air handling units, Electric dermatome, Arterial Blood Gas Analyser, Electrolyte Analyser, Anesthesia workstation, Versa Jet.

Child Rights and You - CRY

Child Rights and You is an Indian non-governmental organization that works towards ensuring happier childhoods for all children. Proposal

Support to refurbish Anganwadi (ICD Centre) in Jamshepur Location. Aim to reposition the ICD Centre as a "vibrant ECD centre" to become the first village outpost for health, nutrition and early learning with adequate infrastructure for ensuring a continuum of care in a life-cycle approach to early childhood care and development, emphasizing the child's physical, cognitive, emotional and social development.

Fund

Fund of Rs. 994,500 released to CRY for an adequate and appropriate infrastructure for one of the ICD Centre including construction of additional rooms, maintenance, and repair of existing buildings for the effective implementation of the scheme. Following specific activities to be undertaken to achieve this:

- Multipurpose room
- Kitchen/store room
- Toilet-child friendly
- Water and electricity facilities
- Examination room/counselling room
- Child friendly Wall-decorations
- Varied unique TLM1 materials and storing cupboards-for PSE2 facilities
- Maintenance costs

Fund

Fund of Rs. 2,730,830 released to Rotary Club of Bharuch for development of 5 schools with below focus:

- Based on the population of students and teachers, gender segregated toilets will be built in each school.
- Commercial RO Drinking water plant to be installed in school for health of students.
- Proper hygienic hand washing facilities at each school.
- Indoor / Outdoor play equipment as per needs of each school.
- Science Laboratory Equipment to each school as per the school needs and as per the Gujarat state board Academic curriculum.
- Computers with Microsoft Windows, Microsoft excel, Power point, Microsoft words software installed. Appropriate Antivirus with parental control in each computer at all schools to block inappropriate content and protect against computer viruses.
- Each School will be provided with 1 Smart interactive board with Gujarat State Board Academic Curriculum installed in it.

Proposal

Requested support of 50 units of mechanical ventilators for government hospitals in Chennai, Chengalpet and Kanchipuram area. This project aims in providing mechanical ventilator to the same set of Government Hospitals who are treating poor and BPL patients affected with Covid-Sars virus.

- Stanley Hospital and the Government Medical College Hospital,
- Omandurar Government Multispecialty Hospital, Chennai
- Chengalpattu Medical College Hospital, Chengalpattu

Fund

Fund of Rs. 22,500,000 released to Lions Club of Chepauk for 50 equipping mechanical ventilators. Approximate cost of each Mechanical Ventilators is 4.5 lakhs/unit. The intent of the project is to procure around 50 units and distribute among the Government hospitals in Chennai, Chengalpattu & Kanchipuram districts to treat the COVID positive patients.

Tata Steel Foundation

Tata Steel Foundation (TSF) has been focusing on initiatives in and around its operational areas to protect the most vulnerable communities. Tata Steel Foundation is located in Mumbai City, Maharashtra. It is classified as a not for profit company.

Proposal

TSF partnered with a renowned apparel manufacturer for a 3 months course- 'Industrial Sewing Machine Operator' after completion of which these trained women will be qualified to get appropriate jobs. TSF have provided infrastructure support to set up one small center (capacity 15 machines) at Noamundi, which is being run by the manufacturer. Based on the success of this model, TSF proposed to scale it up by adding a larger unit (capacity 60 machines) at Bagunhatu, Jamshedpur. Timken India Limited has provided financial support for setting up this training center so that young women can get training free of cost and enhance their skills to get appropriate jobs.

Fund of Rs. 25,00,000 released to TSF for this Project.
