

## **Building of Hockey Turf to Establish Hockey Training Academy for Rural Tribal Youth of Jharkhand**

### **Project Description**

It was proposed to set up a hockey training academy for tribal youth in the tribal hamlets in and around Jamshedpur in East Singhbhum district. Jharkhand has a rich history in producing several renowned hockey players. The state has a large pool of hockey talent who need the right guidance and training to make polished national-level hockey players out of them.

This project was directly implemented by the Company to build the hockey ground with international quality FIH-certified turf. The ground was prepared and handed over to establish the hockey academy.

## **Supporting Infrastructure Development of OPD and setting up of surgical ward, trauma center and emergency services**

### **Project Description**

Acharya Shree Nanesh Hospital in CKD Belapur, Navi Mumbai is a charitable hospital providing medical facilities to all sections of the community at free/subsidized rates. The project included upgrading the Outpatient department (OPD) at the hospital by creating additional OPD units to bring multiple specialties and create more availability of services under one roof. It also included creation of surgical ward, trauma center and emergency services.

**Implementing Agency:** H S Ranka Foundation (CSR00011878)

The hospital is run by H S Ranka Foundation Trust, which was established in October 2005 and registered with the Charity Commission in January 2006. It was founded with an intent of wholesome contribution towards betterment of the community at a public level. The foundation's scope of charitable activities encompasses medical relief, medical infrastructure development, Cancer aide, education, housing, rehabilitation of rural, progressions of other objects of general utility, collective social and cultural advancements.

# Skill Enhancement Training Program for Automotive Mechanics and Technicians

## Project Description

The Skill Certification Scheme is focused at enabling a large number of Indian youths to take up industry-relevant skill training that will help them in securing a better livelihood. Individuals with prior learning experience or skills will also be accessed and certified under Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) component of the scheme. The objective of this project is to upskill 200 technicians in the Commercial Vehicle segment. The program also provides them with tools necessary to carry out their jobs more efficiently.

**Implementing Agency:** Automotive Skill Development Corporation (ASDC) (CSR00004533)

Automotive Skill Development Corporation is a registered non-profit organization in India focusing on developing and upgrading Automotive Skills for Mechanics, Truckers and Automotive workforce. ASDC is the first sector Skill Council of India promoted by the automotive industry, automotive bodies, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRTH), and National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).

## **Donation of school bus to Torang Trust for tribal students at Dayton International School**

### **Project Description**

Torang Trust had stated operating the school in the 2022-23 academic calendar. However, despite their door-to-door campaign to bring more tribal children to the school, they were facing a major challenge of getting them to the school. While parents were ready to send their children to school, the tribal hamlets are scattered, and the schools is too far for the children to walk. Lack of public transport facilities in these locations added to the woes. Therefore, Timken granted funds to Torang Trust to buy a 40-seater school bus to help them bring students from these remote areas to the school & help them get the quality education they need & deserve.

**Implementing Agency:** Torang Trust (CSR00012646)

Torang Trust was established in 2005 under Certificate of Indian Trust Registration and has an FCRA Registration. The trust works in the areas of Protection of child rights, women empowerment, implementation of forest rights act, youth promotional activities, women's rights, and preservation and revitalization of tribal food, art, culture, folklores, and traditions among others. The trust is also promoting, protecting and preserving indigenous system of medicine called Hodopathy (ethno-medicine) in tribal India.

# Construction of Cancer Patient & Attendee Rest House at Meharbai Tata Memorial Hospital

## Project Description

Meharbai Tata Memorial Hospital is a 120-bedded cancer specialty hospital in Jamshedpur that has become the regional center for cancer patients not only for people from Jharkhand, but also from neighbouring states. With the rise in number of cancer patients coming from distant places, there's an increasing demand for affordable lodging & boarding facility close to the hospital. Timken granted funds for the construction of 11,000 sq-ft rest house for patients and their attendants next to the hospital.

This is a direct project where Timken identified the vendors for architect and civil work and awarded contracts to them directly. This Project started in FY 2022-23 and expected to be completed in September 2023.

**Fund:** Rs. 95,34,107 were utilized in FY 2022-23. Rs 2,46,63,101/- earmarked for this project are being transferred to Unspent CSR Account in terms of applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013.
