# Skill Enhancement Training Program for Automotive Mechanics and Technicians

## Project Description

Promoting education and employment enhancing vocational skills: Providing financial support for upskilling mechanics.

**Implementing Agency:** Automotive Skill Development Corporation (ASDC) (CSR00004533)

Automotive Skill Development Corporation is a registered non-profit organization in India focusing on developing and upgrading Automotive Skills for Mechanics, Truckers and Automotive workforce. ASDC is the first sector Skill Council of India promoted by the automotive industry, automotive bodies, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRTH), and National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).

**Fund:** Rs. 13,45,200/- was provided for this Project and it is completely utilized. Skill development training was provided to 201 mechanics.

**Fund:** Rs. 52,93,133/- were utilized in FY 2024-25. Rs. 2,96,95,281/- earmarked for this project are transferred to Unspent CSR Account in terms of applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013.

## **Timken Scholarship for Higher Education**

### **Project Description**

Promoting education and employment enhancing vocational skills: Towards scholarship funding for eligible students pursuing higher education identified through Vidyasaarathi Portal.

The Company has been supporting this initiative for 7 years.

**Implementing Agency:** Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) (CSR00003475)

Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) along with Vidyasaarathi a technology-enabled initiative by Protean works to bridge the gap in education finance in the country through an online platform. Students can search and apply for various education finance schemes for which they qualified. This helps them manage the entire online application lifecycle, i.e., submission and review of application, award of scholarship, disbursement of funds, and renewal of education finance.

**Location:** PAN India

**Fund:** Fund of Rs. 60,00,000/- was provided for this project and it is completely utilized. Scholarship was provided to 135 students.



## **Additional infrastructure upgrades for safety at Meherbai Tata Memorial Hospital**

### **Project Description**

Promoting health care including preventive health care: Infrastructure upgradation for safety (boundary wall, additional staircase for fire safety) at Meherbai Tata Memorial Hospital. The Company has previously helped this project.

This is a direct project where Timken identified the vendors and awarded contracts to them directly. This is an ongoing project and is expected to complete by May 2025.

**Location:** Jamshedpur, Jharkhand

**Fund:** Rs. 1,394,568/- were utilized in FY 2024-25. Rs. 1,582,891/- earmarked for this project transferred to Unspent CSR Account in terms of applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013.

**Location:** Delhi

**Fund:** Rs. 57,98,514/- were provided for this project and it is completely utilized.

### Project Description
